Margie Lohse is supervising test excavations of sites in Liberty County. H.A.S. members are invited to participate anytime during the 10 day period Jan. 5 - 14. The work-day begins with assembly at 7:30 a.m. at a small yellow house near Amstad Well Service Co. This is located on the outskirts of Liberty on Hiway 146 north of town (approximately 1/2 mile past a drive-in; the house is on the right of the road.) Participants are asked to bring their personal excavation equipment and food and water. The day's work will end at 5p.m.

Crews will be led by Margie Lohse and Barbara Burger and will include students from Rice University and the University of Houston.

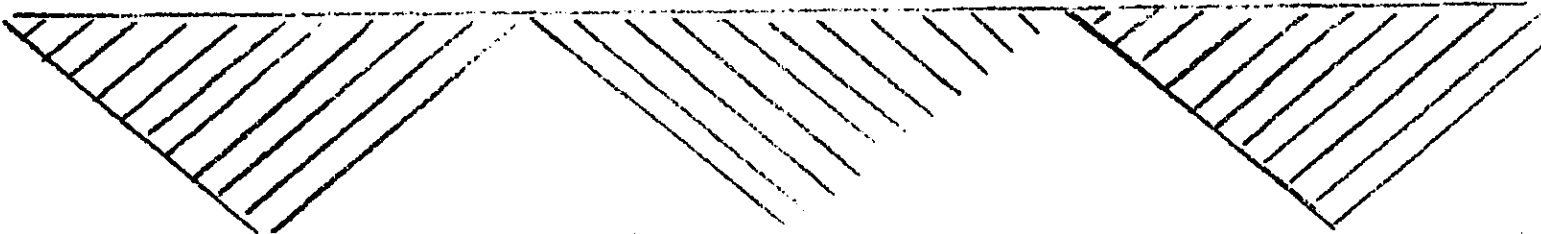

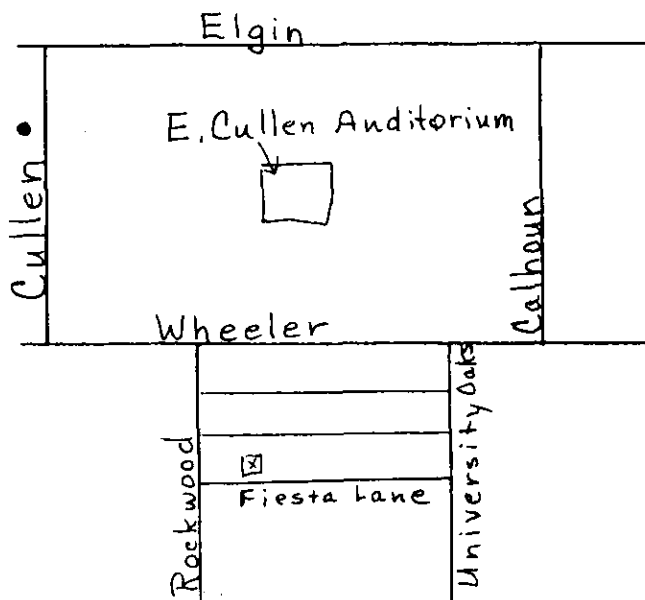

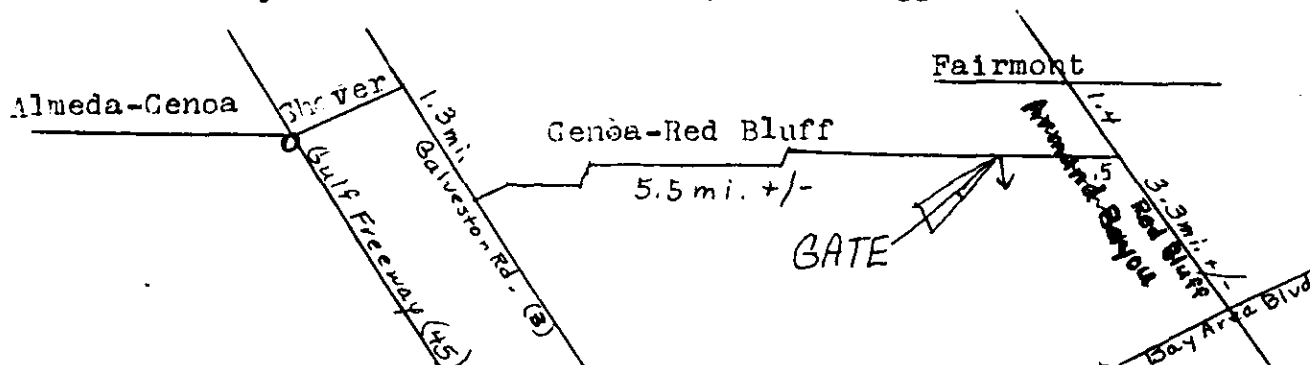
No more lab work at RICE until further notice. They are remodeling the lab.

HAS Field Project: The Wm. Dobie Survey

March 12 and 13 HAS will conduct a survey of the Dobie property on Armand Bayou. The property was first occupied by Wm. Dobie, the great grandfather of J. Frank Dobie, in 1832. We will survey the property for the old bridge or ford, for the old wagon trails, for early housites and prehistoric sites. Testing of the sites that are found will help to relate the period of occupation to the research being done by Dick Gregg with the recorded instruments as well as with the descendants of the earlier settlers. Members of HAS and sponsored groups may participate. A cook out-song fest is planned for Sat. night. Overnight camping without tents is permitted (bring your own gear) for eating, drinking, surveying, and sleeping).

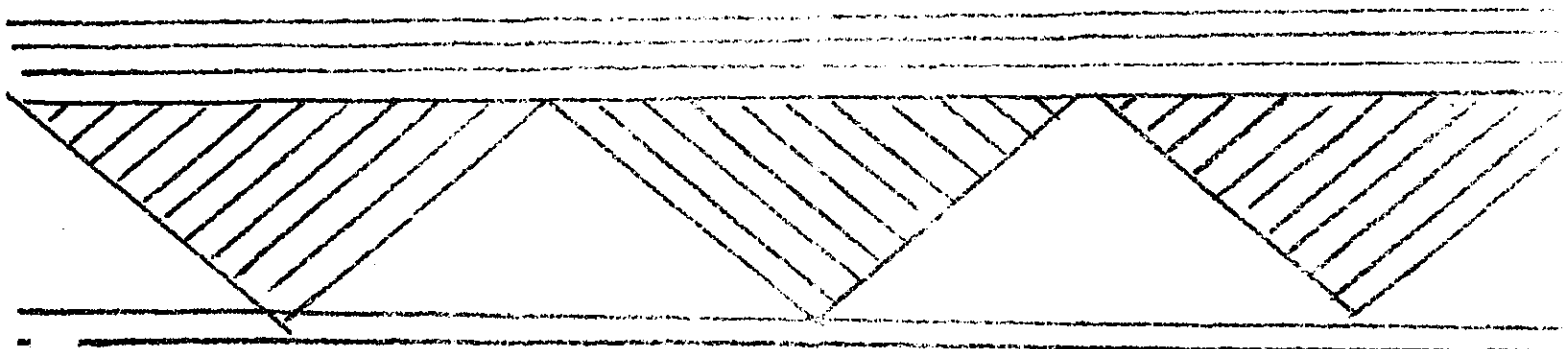

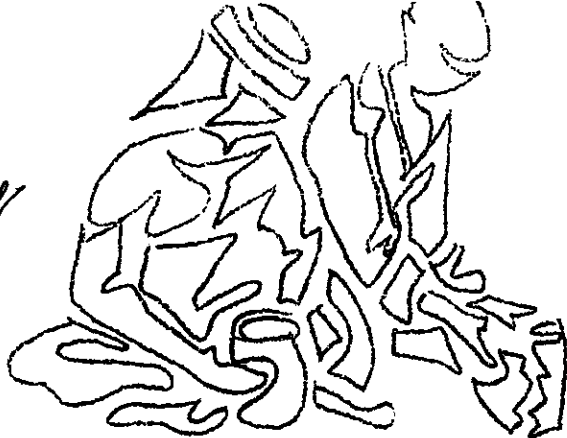

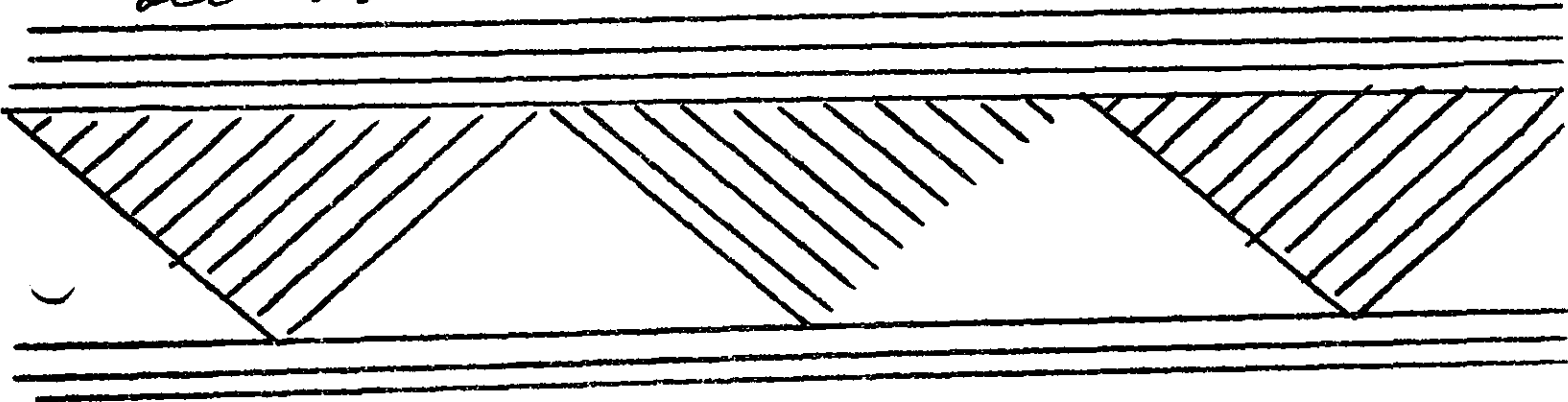
